Your LiveStream

When your church does live stream, do share the stream to your own social media. However, share with a neighborly greeting in the text. If your church only releases recordings, share the recording to your social media with your thoughts on what you learned, not just that it was a good service.



Ex. **“Welcome, friends! Join us in the chat as we worship together.”**

Put your phone on silent (do not disturb) and participate in the chat while you are sitting in the service. Take your sermon notes in the chat.

Use emojis during the online service to express worship to our Savior.

Don't know how to start a conversation?



Ex. **“How is everyone doing?”**

Ex. **“How is the weather where you are?”**

Ex. **“How was your week?”**

Ex. **“Where are you watching from?”**

A person who chats online acts like your greeters and your prayer team throughout the entire service.



- **Facebook: Hit “reply”** on someone to bring them back to the conversation.
- **Write out a prayer** when someone asks for prayer. Make that extra effort for others.
- **You don't need to have all the answers.** If someone asks a question, go look up the answer and tell them you will get back to them.
- **You don't have to be super spiritual** to talk to people. Just be friendly like you would to your neighbors.
- **If you have more than one service**, watch in person during one service and chat online during the next service.
- **Draw out the conversation.** When someone comes into the chat, proactively ask a question.

Inviting People To Church

- **Join local Facebook groups**, and when someone asks about local churches, share the answer to this question: What do you love about your church? Where is your church? What are you learning? Invite them to sit with you.

- **Friend people you meet at in person events.** It's a great way to build up to inviting them to Christmas or Easter services.
